

# BRAND PARTNERSHIP GRANTS GIVING GUIDELINES

#### Foundation

Arby's Foundation is proud to partner with our brand team to provide grants to eligible nonprofit organizations that support youth.

## **ELIGIBLE ORGANIZATIONS**

Organization must be in the United States or one of its territories and must be recognized as one of the following:

- Recognized by and registered with the IRS as a 501(c)(3) charitable organization; or
- Accredited Public PreK-12 School or School District to which contributions are tax deductible under the Internal Revenue Code; or
- Accredited Public or Non-Profit College and University to which contributions are tax deductible under the Internal Revenue Code

## **INELIGIBLE GRANT REQUESTS**

- Grants that do not support youth
- Grants that provide a direct benefit to the employee or employee's family
- Grants made in lieu of tuition payments
- Grants to political or lobbying organizations
- Grants to religious organizations unless funds specifically support a social service need such as a soup kitchen or homeless shelter
- Subscription or membership fees
- Dues to alumni (ae) or similar groups
- Grants to collegiate or professional athletic associations
- Grants to any organization that discriminates based on race, religion, color, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, age, national origin, ancestry, citizenship, veteran, or disability status, or espouses hate

## **GRANT RESTRICTIONS**

Below are several critical points to remember when requesting funds from the Arby's Foundation.

- The Foundation cannot give funds with the recognition going to the brand. Therefore, if recognition is provided for the grant, the Arby's Foundation must be recognized and not Arby's.
- The individual requesting funds cannot receive a personal benefit for a Foundation donation.
- The Foundation is not a cost center. Funds cannot be committed prior to requesting and receiving approval from the Foundation.

## REVIEW AND PAYMENT PROCESS

- Grants committee will review all requests to ensure organization meet guidelines above.
- If request is approved, funds will be paid directly to the organization.
- Funds will be paid within six weeks of organization submitting application and payment information.
